With the latest additions, it has become a full solution to print white on translucent media for window decorations and more.

Textiles are increasingly becoming the default for easy-to-use graphics. The **Avinci CX3200** is a next-generation textile printer that allows for printing on transfer paper and directly on fabrics up to 150 m²/h. This is a major step in high-quality textile printing. Large textile print service providers in Europe have already standardized on this leading textile printer.
